## **TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES**

I belong to professional organizations, attend workshops and educational programs, subscribe to professional publications, and engage in other activities on a continuing basis in order to provide opportunities for professional growth and enhance my own teaching skills.

## **SCHEDULE**

We operate on a semester basis. We build in extra weeks to the calendar as buffers for illness and emergencies. These usually end up as bonus weeks for you.

*If illness or emergency cause a teacher absence more days than the flex calendar has provided, We will do make-up classes.*

*With 24 hours advanced notice, student absences can often be made up by coming to another class and time when there is room available. Don't forget to notify!*

**Tuition of \$594** per student, may be paid at the beginning of each term (There is a \$65 discount for paying in full at the beginning of the semester), or may be divided into six equal payments of \$99.00 per student. If you choose monthly installments for your payment, you must either use the auto-pay function in your account or provide 6 post-dated checks to be kept in our office which we will deposit on the first of each month as they come due. (*Semester One payments:* August thru January; *Semester Two payments:* February thru July. (A \$25 late fee will be applied to any payment that is not made on time.)

**PIANO CLUB** is an all inclusive Membership. We do not charge per lesson. Your payment of \$594 per semester covers the cost of tuition and materials, lending library, piano lab and associated fees & supplies, special events and more.

Tuition is for the school year. Spreading the payment out over monthly increments is for your convenience, payment is due in full whether your student chooses to continue for the next semester or not.
